

Checklist to evaluate assessment rubrics

The following criteria can be used to review and evaluate how well rubrics are designed.

Performance criteria (PC)			
Provide a clear statement that reflects the professional standard or competency/ skills assessed.			
Help learners understand what they need to do and include in any assessment task, behaviour or skill to achieve competence.			
Judgement statements (JS)			
Inform learners explicitly of the qualities and elements of their work that are being looked for to determine how well they have performed against each PC.			
Clearly specify the level of performance expected from the learner for competence.			
Provide observable, measurable and objective statements to evaluate work while minimizing the need for 'expert judgement'.			
Statements cover both a quality and quantifiable performance where appropriate.			
Each statement is clear and distinct distinguishing different levels of performance.			
Simple and clear language is used which learners understand.
